- Mega-sites
 - Planning is underway between the New Jersey Department of Health and the New Jersey State Police Incident Management Team
- Vaccines
 - Estimated to arrive in New Jersey in the middle of December, pending Emergency Use Authorization (EUA)
 - Newsletter released called "Vax Matters"
- Paramedics to Vaccinate
 - o Still under review by the Attorney General's Office
- Twiage Policy
 - o The policy has been removed from the website
 - Under legal review
- New Licensing System
 - o Will be live on January 1, 2021
 - o Training dates will be announced shortly
- OEMS Office
 - Moved to 55 North Willow Street Trenton, NJ 08611
 - o PO Box remains the same
- OEMS Staffing
 - o Jim Sweeney and Andrea Silver have resigned
 - Jeff Thomas will also be leaving OEMS
 - o Clayton and IJ have been temporarily reassigned to vaccination efforts
- Long Term Care (LTC) Facilities
 - o Changes to the testing process while entering a Long-Term Care Facility
 - Two-week pilot program
 - Guidance has been sent to all agencies
 - Agencies are not required to get tested for COVID every single time they enter a Long-Term Care Facility
 - o PPE guidance has been issued
 - When entering a LTC a N95 or equivalent mask approved by CDC and NIOSH, eye protection, gloves and an insolation gown (only for known or suspected positive COVID patients) is required
- Licensing
 - Renewals for company names between A through L are due by December 31, 2020
 - Approximately 90 agencies have not renewed their license.
 - These agencies will automatically go into a temporary ten-day extension
 - If an agency does not renew by January 10, 2021, their license will be retired.

- Education Programs
 - Are required to abide by the Governor's Executive orders as it pertains to decontamination procedures, social distancing, and proper utilization of PPE
 - EMS education is considered an Emergency Response Activity and does not apply to the newest executive order for social gathering sizes
- CEU Approval Process
 - o 2019 Process
 - In 2019 the elective CEU process changed, allowing educators to submit classes and receive approval of those in an abbreviated time frame. This process allowed the educators to create a class and determine the CEU value without OEMS review. This process and the corresponding user agreement were approved and implemented under the previous administration, which has raised many concerns.
 - o 2021/New Process
 - All submissions for classes to be conducted on or after January 1, 2021 shall be submitted at least 30 calendar days prior to the class start date.
 - Applications will require submission of all supporting class documentation such as objectives, outlines, examinations, curriculum, hand-outs, etc.
 - The user agreement is considered invalid and has been voided.
 - OEMS will continue to conduct the pre-scheduled training sessions for the njems.us system next week
