GPD Program Models

Bridge Housing: intended to be a short-term stay (averaging 90 days) for Veterans who have been offered and have accepted a permanent housing intervention but are not able to immediately enter.

<u>**Clinical Treatment:**</u> provides transitional housing in conjunction with clinical services effective in helping homeless Veterans secure permanent housing and increase income.

<u>Service-Intensive Transitional Housing</u>: provides transitional housing and robust services that facilitate individual stabilization, increased income, and movement to permanent housing as rapidly as clinically appropriate.

Eligibility Criteria:

- \Rightarrow Veteran must be homeless
- \Rightarrow Must be a Veteran under the USDVA guidelines
- \Rightarrow Applicant must be drug and alcohol free at the time of admission
- \Rightarrow Must be registered with the NJVAHCS. Please Contact the Health Eligibility Center at (877) 222-8387 to start this process.
